

# **LANDISVILLE POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The following Rules and Regulations have been established for the mutual safety and benefit of all members and guests of the Landisville Pool.

## **General:**

- All members and guests use the pool and facilities at their own risk.
- The Landisville Pool is not responsible for any accident, injury, theft, loss or damage of property.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on Landisville Pool property.
- Smoking is not permitted on Landisville Pool property.
- Profane or abusive language is not permitted.
- Action resulting in damage to Landisville Pool property will be charged to the responsible member.
- Only authorized personnel are permitted in the desk and office areas.
- An adult member (16 years of age and older) must accompany all guests.
- Guests must be registered by an adult member, with an adult membership card, at the front desk prior to utilizing the facilities.
- Guests are the responsibility of the host member and the host member will be accountable for their guest's conduct.
- Guest fees are posted at the front desk.
- Members shall present their membership cards when entering the facilities.
- Membership privileges are not transferable.
- Members may not utilize the facilities unless authorized personnel are present.
- Members are requested to wear appropriate attire.
- The Rules and Regulations stated herein may be enforced by the management of Landisville Pool as appropriate.

## **Pool and Diving Areas:**

- No one may utilize the pool unless a lifeguard is present.
- Actions and/or noises, which distract the lifeguards, are prohibited.
- Only authorized personnel are permitted on the lifeguard stands.
- Swimmers are requested to wear appropriate bathing attire. No street clothes are permitted.
- Infants and toddlers who are still in diapers **MUST** wear either a "swim diaper" or plastic pants with elastic around the waist and legs.
- Running in the pool area is prohibited.
- Horseplay, or any rough behavior or action deemed by a pool guard or management as a practice that may create injury to oneself or others, such as running, pushing, shoving, wrestling, dunking, chicken fighting, and towel snapping, is not permitted in or around the pool area.
- Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time.
- No one may enter the diving area except from the diving board.
- Do not dive until the previous diver has safely cleared the diving area.
- Excessive bouncing is not permitted on the diving board.
- Children unable to swim out of the diving area unaided are not permitted to use the diving boards.
- Only authorized personnel may adjust the diving boards
- Diving is not permitted in the shallow area indicated by the red paint.
- Flotation devices are not permitted.

- Inflatable tubes or toys are prohibited in the large pool, (the exception is designated “raft nights”).
- Parents must obtain consent from pool management for any child who is over the age of 5 before they are permitted in the baby pool. Any child older than 5 years may be asked to leave baby pool area if they are interfering with those who are of age.
- Children must be supervised at all times while using the wading pool.
- Children in the wading pool are the responsibility of the parents, not of the lifeguards.
- All private and/or public lessons are to be coordinated by the management of Landisville Pool.

**Health and Safety:**

- Pets are not allowed on the premise.
- The pool may be closed at the discretion of the management.
- Members exhibiting open cuts, wounds, rashes, or abrasions should check with the management before utilizing the pool.
- Children under 12 years of age are not permitted to utilize the facilities without supervision of a parent or legal guardian.
- Refuse and recyclables should be disposed of in the appropriate containers provided.
- Throwing stones or other sharp objects into the pool is prohibited.
- Cooking devices are not permitted in the pool area.
- Glass containers are not permitted in the pool area.

The Board of Directors may amend these Rules and Regulations at any time, as deemed appropriate.
